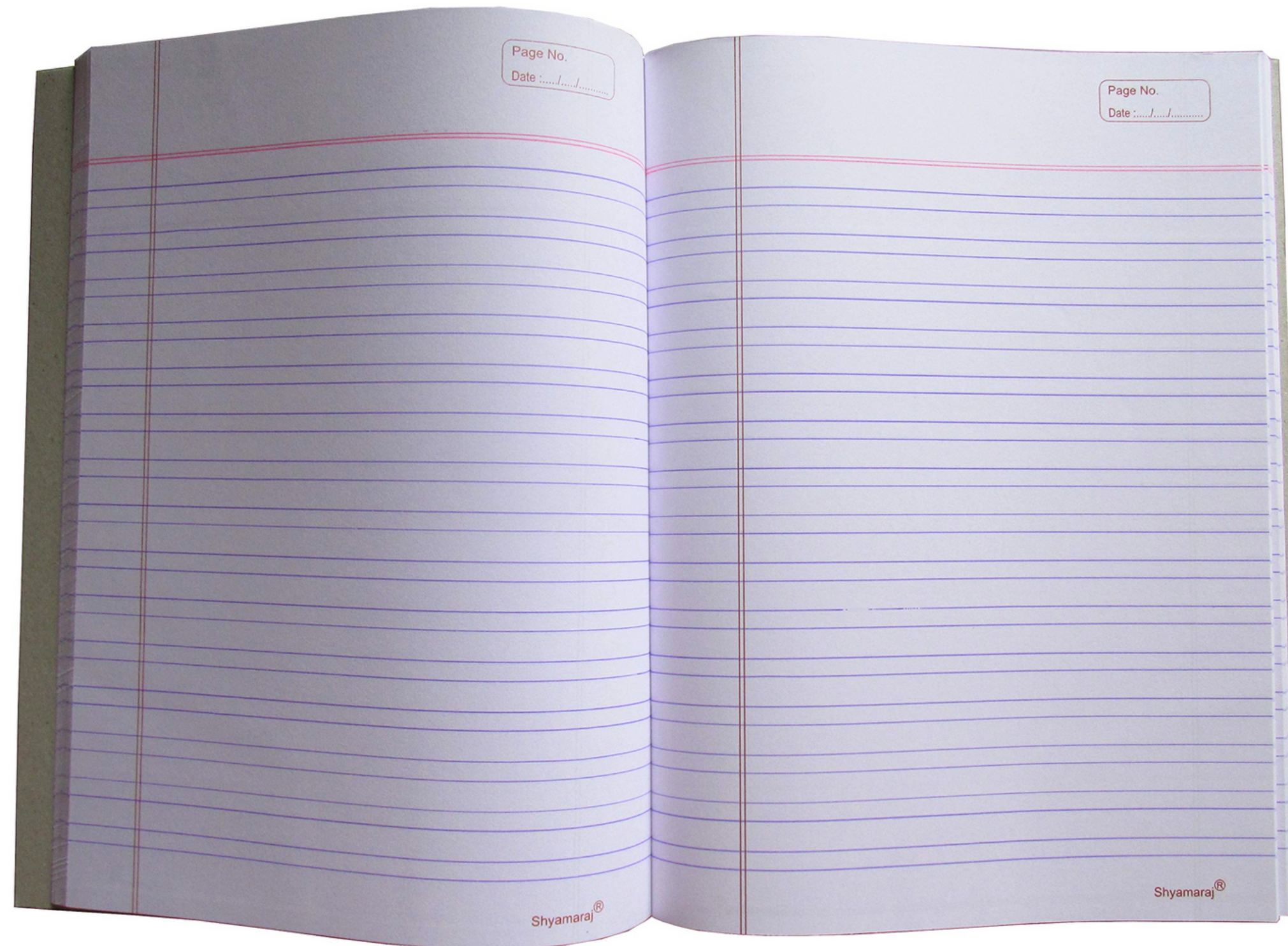

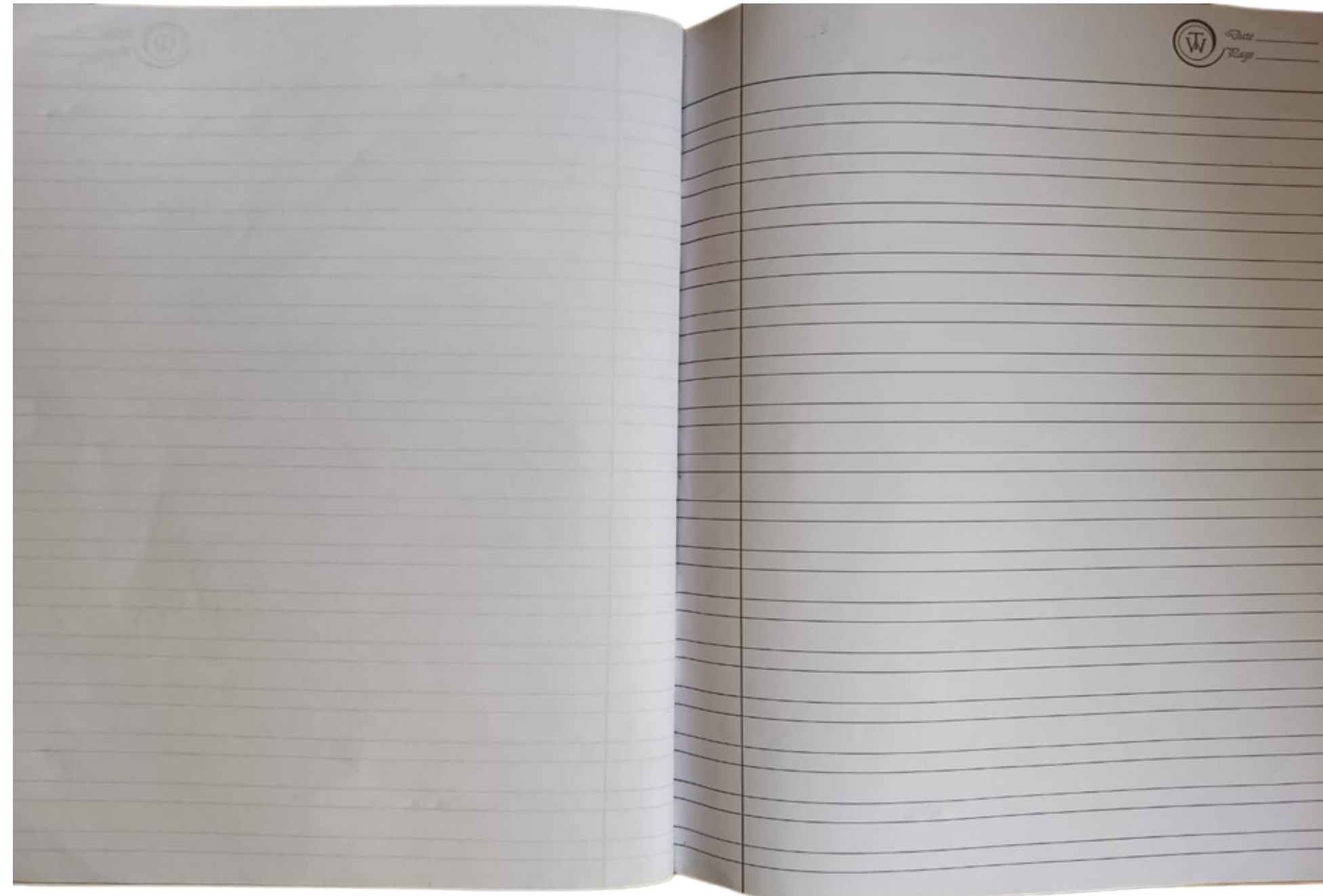

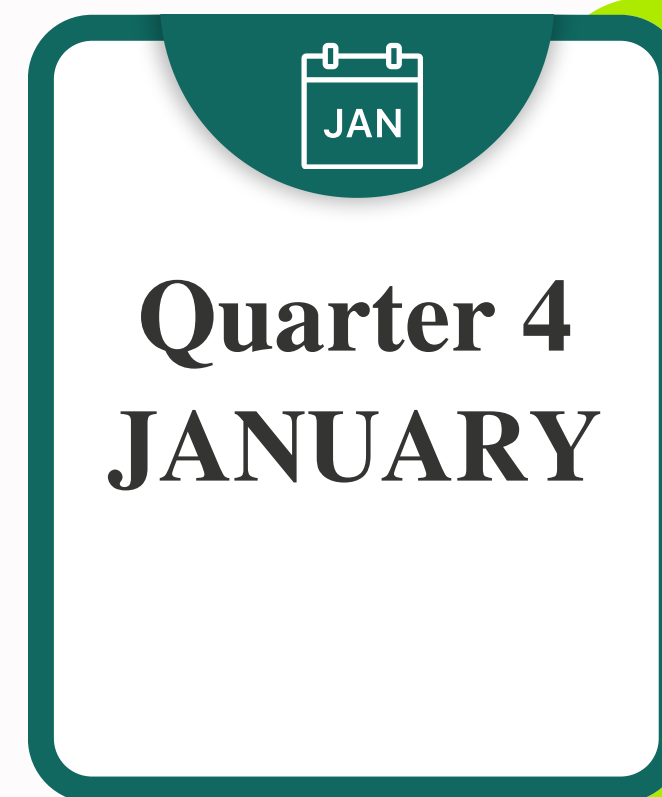
Daily Schedule & Routine

Children will go class wise for field visits; like last year we visited Lucknow Museum.

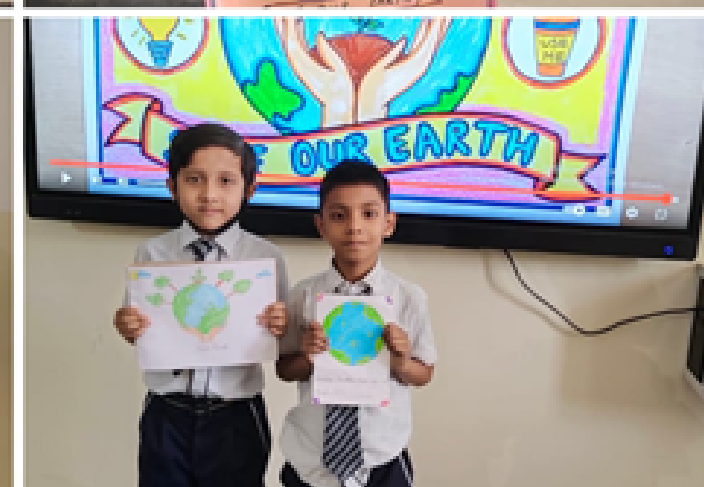

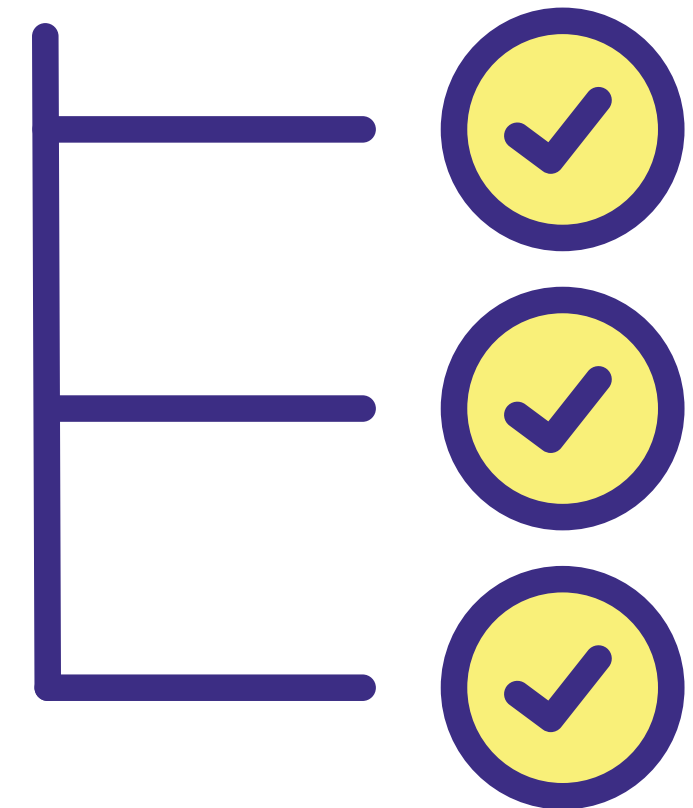

Assessment and Evaluation:



There will be 4 Assessments.

In each assessment, any one activity will be taken of 5 marks each in each subject like-

JAM

(Just a Minute)

In JAM activity the student will be given any topic related to the chapter, the student has to speak on that topic at least for 50 seconds to increase their oral skills.

Role Play

Similarly in role play, the student has to play the role of any character related to the chapter.

Quiz

Different kinds of Quiz will be held team wise in class.

Minute Paper

In minute paper, different topics i.e. out of the syllabus will be explained by the teacher, students have to listen to it carefully and then write the answer of the given questions.

TAKING CARE OF HEALTH
